




### **ROOTED FOR SUCCESS**

Dimpho: Hlompho Hlompho: Dimpho















# **Tritech Science Expo**













Unfortunately all our Grade 6's and 7's were knocked out by the 3rd round.


Well done to all for trying their best and having the confidence to participate.
