Procedure for Academic Awards at Thorntree Preparatory School

From Grade 4 the following is applicable:

We will start this initiative from January 2020, any points received before then are not applicable to ensure all is fair.

- 1. To reach 80% or above aggregate per term:
  - 1 point will be awarded in Grade 4
  - 2 points in grade 5
  - 3 points in Grade 6
  - 4 points in Grade 7
- 2. When a child achieves a maximum of 24 points they will be awarded academic colours. If the child receives 36 points, academic honours will be awarded.

The point system also allows children who miss out on a particular term to still receive these awards. It should also give them a period of time to proudly wear the honours badge. It is also important to note that colours and honours are awarded for excellent, sustained achievement over a period of time.

Children who start at Thorntree Preparatory School after the beginning of Grade 4 must produce their existing reports to be considered being awarded academic points. This remains at the discretion of the Head.

Children who improve their Term average from the previous term will receive a certificate at the end of the term.

Grade 4, improvement of 6% and more

Grade 5, improvement of 6% and more

Grade 6, improvement of 4% and more

- Grade 7, improvement of 4% and more
- A Child that qualifies for both academic bar and certificate, will receive both.

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
